Event: 12 separate individual events as Under 8, 10, 12, 14, 16 and 18 years, Open and Girls.

Time Control: 19th-Rapid -15 Minutes + 10 Second In. 20th -Blitz -3Minutes + 2 Second In.

Eligibility: Those who fall into the respective age group on the 1st of January 2019 are eligible to participate in that age group. **Rated players, will get direct entry for the finals**. They are not allowed to play this event.

Registration: All those who are interested should register with their regional CFSL Officials or by sending an email to undersign on or before 17th January 2019 at 9.00 pm. (eroshj@yahoo.com)

All players who register via email will have to pay the entry fees before the end of the second round at the latest. The Players are expected to hand over payments and not wait for the Arbiters to come asking for payments.
